## Supernatural Pt 7

### You have power over the enemy

Acts 19:11, gives a hilarious picture of religious people getting their arses kicked. Some Christians are the same, getting kicked from pillar to post because they don't know who they are in Jesus. They don't know who Jesus is. They don't believe in the whole supernatural. They think this life and world is just physical and natural where we just engage mentally, emotionally and physically. But it is spiritual and we must learn to engage spiritually for the bible says in Ephesians 6:12 "our fight is not with flesh and blood" and in 2Corinthians 10:3 it says: "though we live in the world we don't wage war on a worldly level for the weapons we fight with are divine". (supernatural).

God is a spirit and spirit to spirit does He speak (Romans 8:16). The devil is also a spiritual being and he will attack us in various ways.

### The work of satan

You would be a thinking person if you acquainted all suffering and atrocities to humanity. Yes we can and do ourselves a lot of damage. But John 10:10 says that the devil has come to kill, steal and destroy. The bible attributes a number of things to the work of satan:-

In fact 40% of the healings that Jesus conducted were the casting out of evil spirits. It is good for us to know what the devil can do, but better for us to know what Jesus has done.

#### What has Jesus done?

We need to know how Jesus has responded to this, for it says in 1 John 3:8: *"for this reason the Son of man came to destroy the works of the devil"*.

Where there was sickness He brought healing

Where there was sin and guilt He brought forgiveness (John 8)

Where there was death He brought life (John 11)

Where there was wrong He brought right (Matthew 19:1- 10)

Where there was poverty He brought prosperity

Where there was turmoil He brought peace.

Then on the cross he finalized it as it declares in Colossians 2:13 - 15 and as He declared on the cross those victorious words *"it is finished"* not I am finished. But the work of the devil is finished.

#### But why does he still operate?

Because the devil is a lawbreaker. The bible refers to him as a schemer, a deceiver, a prowler, a thief and a liar. He is the falsifier of information. He is the manipulator of a bad report. He is the distorter of truth, his name is Beelzebub (Lord of the flies), looking for a hurt, an open cut, disappointment, offence, somewhere he can lay his eggs.

#### So what must I do in response?

1. Get a hold of Jesus and what he has done on the cross. Realise he died for us and everything He went through was so that we could walk in the fullness of the life God has for us.

He became sin so we can be righteous 2Corinthians 5:21

He became cursed so we could be blessed Galatians 3:13

He became sick so we could be healed Isaiah 53:4 - 6 and 1Peter 2:24

He became poor so we can be rich 2Corinthians 8:9

He was separate so we can be accepted

He went to hell so we could go to heaven Matthew 27:46 1Thessalonians 1:8 - 9

2. Understand the ramifications that work has on us and rise up in it. 2Corinthians 5:17: *"Therefore if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation, the old has gone, the new has come."* Ephesians 1:18 - 23 please read and pray about this

3. Put on the armour Ephesians 6:10 - 20. Encourages us to put on the full armour of God. Let me in brief help you understand what that means. The belt of truth, is a lifestyle and a condition of character and value system. The breast plate of righteousness is a revelation of the forgiven heart. The feet shed with readiness is a life of action and obedience. The shield of faith is a belief system. The helmet is an attitude and a way of thinking. The sword of the spirit is a revelation of the word of God.

4. Take authority over the work of the enemy In prayer, lifestyle and in direct command, cast out, evict, pray over, step on, in your lifestyle and actions, the work of the enemy in people's lives, situations and over our homes, churches and communities.

## Argentina

For the past 2 months we have started Thursday night prayer meetings and are amazed at the hunger of the people in coming to pray. People are turning up at the prayer meetings 15 - 30 minutes before the doors open, that's a miracle in itself because Argentine people are not punctual and usually turn up to meetings 30 minutes later. There have been between 30 - 50 people turning up at every prayer meeting. Unbelievers are also hearing about the meetings and are also coming and end up getting saved. Last Thursday night during the prayer 9 people made first time decisions to follow Christ and got saved. We praise the Lord for the harvest that is taking place here in San Juan. In the last 8 weeks we have seen over 20 new souls turn to Christ, through friendship, evangelism, with most of them being professionals. Every Saturday we teach, feed and care for over 50 children from the poorest areas. It has been 18 months and the Lord has blessed us now with a congregation of over 120 members, to Him alone be the glory. At the moment we are teaching the poor, skills and helping them in starting their own small businesses. The first project is teaching hairdressing to the ladies from the poor areas, and then we will help them in set up their own hairdressing salon. The second project is a plant and garden business.
